Complete entries via email, payment via Venmo **Or** USPS Mail **complete entries**, with payment by check

Ride Times will be posted on SDF's Facebook page

Arrive no more than 60 minutes prior to your ride time.

Check in with the parking attendant so you don't get boxed in.

Pick up your bridle tag and entry packet at the unmanned check in. Leave a SASE for Awards.

Competitor +1
 Coach **or** Groom only

Coach and competitor can enter warm up no more than 30 minutes prior to your ride time.

Those sharing a coach, groom or trailer will be scheduled together instead of by class.

Our Ring Steward will move you through warm up to your ride. Ride times will be strictly followed. Please depart no more than 30 minutes after your ride.

Masks are required unless mounted or clearly beyond a 6' distance with no chance of interaction.

Rides may not be grouped by class and will be processed after the show and published to the farm Facebook page.

If you leave a self-addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) with appropriate postage, your test & ribbon will be mailed to you.

Why

We will be scheduling rides to group people together who are sharing rides, grooms or coaches. **Please communicate information that would be helpful to us.**

We are not able to accept payment or entry changes the day of the show to limit face:face contact.

We will be closing the check in booth and inside facility to limit cross-contamination. This means: **No shared water access** – bring your own supply. **No restroom** – I95 has clean public facilities less than 5 minutes away. **No day or overnight stalls.**

The goal is to move people through as quickly as possible, reduce the people here at one time and limit contact face:face

By limiting time here, we have ample space for coaches and competitors to keep physical distance

We need you to be efficient and self-sufficient in your time here. This will allow us to minimize loitering, socializing without distancing and stay within the 50 people rule. **Show secretary/manager can be reached at 207-322-6282**

We do not want people waiting for their scores.

Competitors who do not leave a SASE will not receive a copy of their test. We recognize this is an additional cost to you and apologize for that, however it's not a cost we can absorb in the show fees.

Class Notes:

CLASS 1 and 2 = Same horse and rider combination cannot show in Training Level or above.

CLASS 3 = Same horse and rider combination cannot show above Training Level Test 1.

CLASS 6 and 9 = Does not count for show high point awards. Does count for year-end awards.

CLASS 17 = Not allowed to compete in any tests. Not allowed to ride in the show ring.

- **AWARDS:** Six ribbons in each class awarded for JR, AA and Open. Ribbon for Champion and Reserve Champion. Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, cap, or cancel classes as entries warrant.
- **ENTRIES:** Forms available on SMDA website. Complete entries are processed according to postmark date. Pre-entries are not accepted. Make checks payable to Scarlet Day Farm. Once the show is full, entries are placed on a wait list. **Entries must include:** Negative Coggins within 36 months for in-state horses; within 12 months for out-of-state horses. Full payment including class fees and other fees. **Class Fees:** \$25/class. \$15/schooling on grounds. **Other Fees:** \$5 office fee. \$35 for nonnegotiable check. \$10 SMDA non-member fee. *No refunds after closing date, including Acts of God, except for wait list entries not scheduled. USDF and USEF rules and regulations are followed.
- **TIMES:** Tentative times are posted the Thursday prior to the show date on @ScarletDayFarm facebook page. Official show times on day sheet provided at check-in on show day and will be followed.
- **STABLING:** **NOT AVAILABLE FOR THIS SHOW**
- **DIRECTIONS:** From I95 (NB or SB), take exit 63. Turn right onto US-202 (Gray Road). Travel for 0.1 mile. Turn right onto Center Road. Travel 1.7 miles on Center Road. Farm is on the left. Please see attendant to check-in/park.
- **FOOTING:** 100 x 200 (outdoor) sand arena for showing and 70 x 140 (covered) sand arena for warm-up. Intro through Training Level 2 held in small arena. Training Level 3 and above held in large arena. Musical Freestyle and Western Dressage held in large arena.
- **FOOD:** No food available on show grounds. Convenience stores located within 1 mile of the show grounds. Potable water available for horses and humans. **NOT AVAILABLE FOR THIS SHOW**
- **OTHER:** No dogs allowed on grounds. Photographer onsite the day of the show. Please see facebook and/or photographer to order prints. Jackets required unless waived by judge. Farm rules posted for warm-up and show ring must be followed with a focus on a kind, supportive environment for horse and rider.
